Welcome to the Saint Teresa Casita Newsletter. The aim of this publication is to keep you informed on the progress, activities and items of interest as they pertain to this charitable organization.

Since the Casita is named after Saint Teresa it seems appropriate that we start with her. As you may know, she was a women of small stature. But what she lacked in height was offset

by the enormity of the love she had in her heart. That love was for the poor, the hungry, the afflicted – the Outcasts of Society. Her life was dedicated to the needy so it's no wonder that the Casita is dedicated to her and her mission. The mission statement, "serving those in greatest need" was inspired by this great saint.

Unlike Saint Teresa, we don't have to travel to Calcutta to serve the forgot-

ten of Society. They exist here in our own backyard. The Casita has a growing list of the needy here in San Pedro. You most likely encounter them every day. The Casita started in September 2017 and distributed what it could when it could – a bag of flour and used clothing. The count at that time was between 10 and 20 visitors. It has grown to current levels of between 30 to 35 visitors on distribution days. The needs are growing to a point where the Casita has had to expand the distribution days to twice monthly.

The duties of the Casita don't just involve the distribution of goods. Visitation of the home bound; poor, needy, lonely and our visitors, are conducted to let them know that they are not the forgotten of society. All distribution days include an element of prayer and visitors are encouraged to say a little prayer or stop by the church and offer thanks to Our Lord.

- Food flour, rice, beans, sugar, cooking oil, powdered milk, canned goods, baking powder, allspice, pepper, peanut butter, jam, etc.
- Hygiene tooth brushes, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, shampoo, toilet paper, etc.
- Infant items diapers, baby oil, baby powder, ointment, clothing, baby wipes, etc.
- Stationery and school supplies
- Monetary single and monthly donation options available

We wish to thank existing donors but encourage more donors. As noted, the need continues to increase.

A basket is available at the back of the church at weekend masses for donations of goods listed previously. Monetary donations, in the envelopes provided, can be included with the regular mass collections. Please give generously.

The third part: Volunteers. It is said that "many hands make light work". We need many hands in light of the work we need to do. The functioning of the Casita is
